THE LIBYA (RESTRICTIVE MEASURES)(OVERSEAS TERRITORIES) ORDER 2011

The Libya (Restrictive Measures)(Overseas Territories) Order 2011 came into force on 9 April 2011. The Order was made as a result of the United Nations Security Council Decision 1970 (2011) adopted on 26 February 2011 and resolution 1973 (2011) adopted on 17 March 2011.

The Order calls upon member states to introduce restrictive measures in respect of Libya and on particular persons responsible for the violations of human rights and international humanitarian law in Libya.

The Order includes a prohibition on the supply of arms and related material and equipment, and further prohibition on making funds and economic resources to individuals as set out in Annex 11 of the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1970/2011.
