PRESS RELEASE

THE SYRIA (RESTRICTIVE MEASURES)(OVERSEAS TERRITORIES) ORDER 2011

The Syria (Restrictive Measures)(Overseas Territories) Order 2011 came into force on

15 July 2011. The Order was made as a result of the European Union in Council Decision

2011/273/CFSP on 9 May 2011. It was implemented in the European Union Council Regulation

(EU) No. 442/2011 and adopted on 10 May 2011.

The Order calls upon member states to introduce restrictive measures in relation to Syria and on

particular persons responsible for the violent repression against the civilian population in Syria.

The Order includes a prohibition on the supply and delivery of arms, the freezing of funds and

economic resources and further prohibition on making funds and economic resources to

individuals as set out in Annex 11 of the Council Regulation (EU) No. 504/2011.
